

TWS Level 2 - Confined Space Entry

Attention Managers - Health & Safety Supervisors

Workplaces with one or more confined spaces must ensure all employees working in or around the hazardous area have received Confined Space Entry training and certification. Workers in British Columbia are required to have comprehensive training that meets *CSA standard Z1006-16 Management of Work in Confined Spaces* and *WorkSafeBC's Workers Compensation Act, Part 3: OHS and Occupational Health and Safety Regulation, Part 9: Confined Spaces*.

WorkSafe BC requires employers and supervisors to be responsible for ensuring all workers are:

- Adequately trained and certified
- Provide direct supervision and correct unsafe acts/conditions
- Ensure only authorized, adequately trained workers operate equipment
- Maintain health and safety standards

Intended Audience - Course Overview

This course is intended for all employees who enter into Non-IDLH (immediately dangerous to life or health) confined space atmospheres.

Participants will be provided with comprehensive theory and site-specific training with a practical introduction to confined space entry programs, hazard assessments, use and care of safety equipment, entry procedures, and rescue plans required for confined space entry.

This course will verify employee understanding and management of confined space hazards, precautions and applicable regulations as stated in CSA Z1006 standards and WorkSafeBC OHSR Part 9: Confined Spaces and related guidelines.
