All persons who transfer propane must have a certificate of qualification resulting from the successful completion of a training course recognized and approved by the Technical Safety BC, Gas Safety Manager. A recognized training course must have been submitted for review and acceptance to a Provincial Safety Manager as listed on the Directive. All training must be delivered by qualified instructors, authorized by a training provider and approved by a TSBC Gas Safety Manager.
